From 2007 to 2017, he was Chairman of the Management Board of AlpTransit Gotthard AG, responsible for leading the construction of the Gotthard Base Tunnel, one of the most challenging infrastructure projects in Switzerland to date. He currently serves on the board of directors of various companies.
