

Swisscom shares are listed (SCMN. VX CH0008742519) on the Swiss Stock Exchange and are also traded by the Bank of New York in the USA. A total of 51,801,943 registered shares at a face value of CHF 1.— are held by around 72,000 shareholders. 51% of shares are held by the Swiss Confederation. A dividend of CHF 22 per share was paid in 2022. Market capitalisation on the balance sheet date of 31 December 2022 amounted to CHF 26,243 million.
