## New in the App Store



### Dropbox app

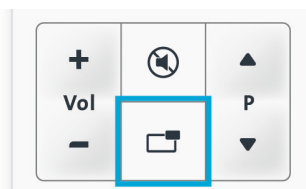
Customers can use the Dropbox app to view photos, play back videos and listen to music stored in their Dropbox account on their television. When the customer first opens the app, a message will be displayed stating that the application needs to be connected to their Dropbox user account. Users can establish this connection easily using their computer or smartphone.



### Deezer app

Customers with a Deezer account can now also enjoy listening to their music via Swisscom TV 2.0. Deezer offers a selection of over 35 million songs and a large number of radio stations. Where necessary, a Deezer Premium Account can be created at <http://deezer.swisscom.ch>

## Other new features



### Improved «Recent» function

Swisscom has made further improvements to the function that allows users to quickly switch between the last two channels viewed via the «Recent» button. This now also includes the Replay, recording-and VoD functions.



### DMR DLNA service (beta)

This service allows customers to view photos and play back films and music stored on their smartphones or tablets via their televisions. This service is easy to use – all customers have to do to view and play their favourite content on the TV is install the DLNA controller application on their mobile devices. There is a wide range of DLNA controller applications available. For example, the «iMediaShare» app is suitable for iOS and Android users. When using an app from a third-party provider, the customer must accept their terms and conditions of use.
