


Detection and alerts


Use of data for police investigations

Stored CCTV data can be accessed at any time to support the police in a criminal investigation. Only authorised people have access to the data in compliance with the Swiss Data Protection Act.




Data security and legal principles



Monitoring of recycling collection points

Modern video cameras are able to identify vehicle license plates – even at high speed. Vehicles can therefore be checked when entering a car park, for example, to confirm whether they have permission to enter. The cameras also help simplify payment processes.
