

# Installing the USB WLAN Adapter

## for Mac OS X

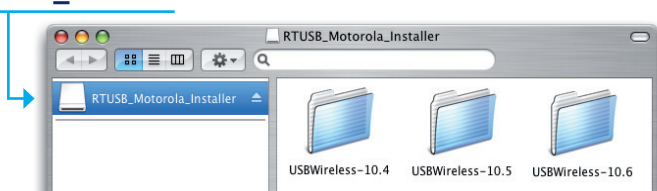
### Install the driver

- 1 Select under [www.swisscom.ch/wlan](http://www.swisscom.ch/wlan) > **USB WLAN Adapter (drivers and instructions)** > **Mac OSX**.

Double-click on:



and select **RTUSB\_Moto\_Installer**.



- 2 Select the folder containing your OS\* (10.4 or 10.5). Start the installation et follow the instructions until the programme is installed on your computer. Restart your computer.

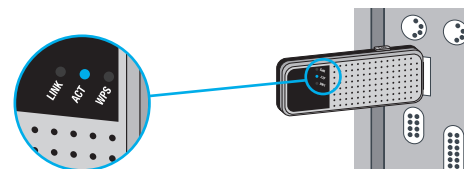
\*you can find out which version your OS is by clicking on the upper left side of your computer > and selecting > About this Mac >



### USB WLAN Adapter

- 3 Insert the **USB WLAN Adapter** into one of the available **USB ports** on your computer. If your computer is placed under your desk use the provided extension. This will improve the quality of reception of the adapter.

- 4 Wait until the **light indicator ACT** on the USB WLAN Adaptor goes on.

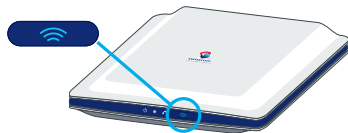


## Do you have a Centro grande (router)?

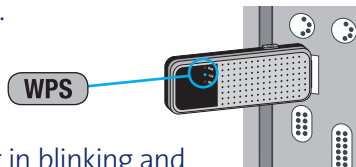


- 5 Router:** press the **WLAN button** for 5 seconds then release.

The WLAN button is now blinking.



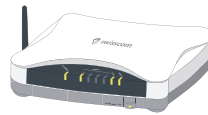
- 6 USB WLAN-Adapter:** press the **WPS button** for 5 seconds then release..



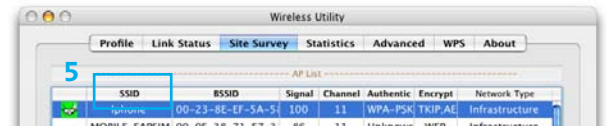
The WPS light indicator is blinking and the installation assistant starts on your screen.

After ca. 2 minutes you can see that the installation has been successful. (In case an error message appears on your screen, repeat steps 5–6).

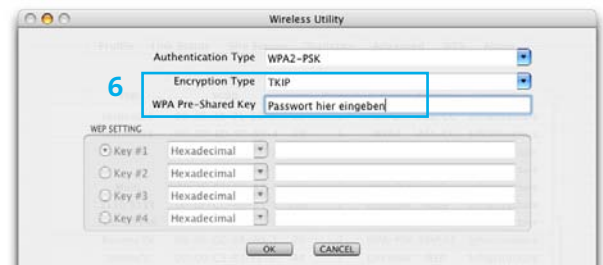
## Do you have another DSL-Router?



- 5** Double-click on the desired **network (SSID)\***.



- 6** Select **TKIP** as an Encryption Type. Enter the **WPS Pre-shared Key\***.



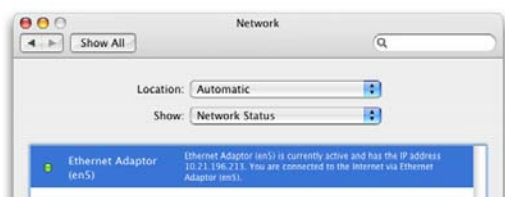

## Enter the OSX settings

- 7** Click on the upper part of your screen on > > **System Preferences** > **Network**.

- 8** In > **Show** > **Network Port Configurations** select the new network then click on > **Apply Now**

The new connection is displayed under **Network Status**.
